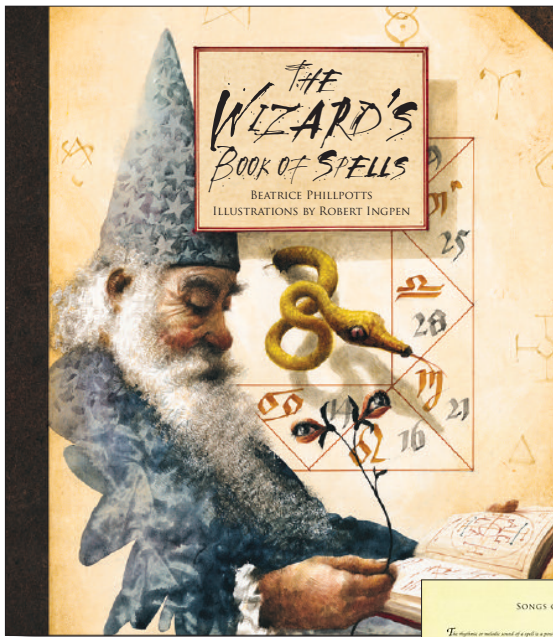


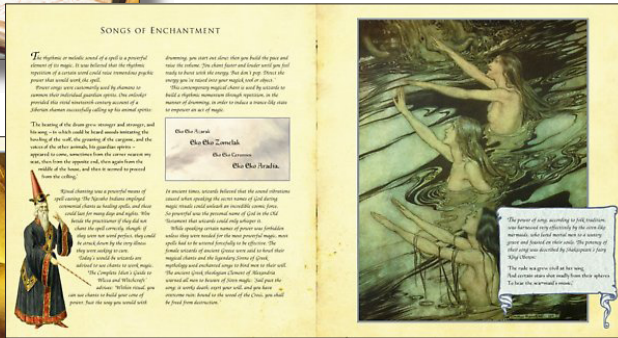

Robert Ingpen is well known for illustrating editions of classic works produced by Palazzo Editions such as *The Jungle Book*, *Peter Pan* and *Wendy*, *Treasure Island*, *The Wind in the Willows* and *Alice in Wonderland*. He began studying illustration, art and book design at The Royal Melbourne Institute of Technology. In 1986 he was awarded the Hans Christian Andersen Medal, for his contribution to children's literature, and recently he was honoured with the Membership of the Order of Australia.
